### EXECUTIVE ORDER

The 90<sup>th</sup> Human Resource Committee of the Ministry discussed on the following two categories of candidates availing long term trainings for which the Ministry has to streamline their extension proposal:

1. They fail in the examinations; and
2. They stay back to obtain an additional degree

Therefore, the HRC has taken the following decisions:

1. On the first category of candidates: Hence forth, the candidates, who are undergoing PG courses, should submit their performance on 6-monthly basis. If they could not perform well from the first semester, MoH/Government will discontinue the stipend. Further, if they fail to obtain the degree, the candidates will have to abide by the prevailing BCSR rules.
2. On the second category of candidates: Ministry shall stick to the Executive Order issued earlier vide order no. HRD/02 (01) MoH/2008/2654 dated October 14, 2008.
