

### EXECUTIVE ORDER

Officials who are currently pursuing long term trainings are requesting the Ministry to extend their course duration approved by the RCSC and the Ministry. The request for course extension may reflect that the concerned officials are either not studying or taking the training course lightly. Also there is cost implication which is further compounded by the shortage of human resources to deliver effective health services. The Human Resource Committee (HRC) recommended that henceforth, Ministry will not entertain any request for course extension beyond what has been approved by the RCSC and the Ministry.

Similarly, some of the officials who are pursuing their approved modules are requesting the Ministry for permission to take additional modules wherever there is cost involved. Due to budget constraints, the HRC recommended that Ministry would not be in a position to approve such courses where there are budgetary implications. However, officials can undertake additional courses without financial implication and time extension.

In line with the above recommendations and the approval of the Ministry, henceforth the Ministry will not entertain any **appeal for course extension and additional courses** for officials who are currently pursuing their long term courses.
