

## **Minutes of the third Task Force meeting convened on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2009.**

The Chair Person for the Task Force informed the members that WHO has decided for the time being to use the name as “Inf A (H1N1)” in place of Swine Flu. The meeting basically emphasized on the need to follow up seriously on all the outcomes and recommendation of the previous two meetings.

### Discussion and outcome

#### Supplies:

- PPEs to be distributed to all hospitals of remaining 11 districts. Supply of PPE will be requested to WHO and if WHO is not able to supply, it will be procured from NIPR project (World Bank)
- Existing Antiviral to be distributed to referral hospitals. Mr. Kaka will follow up.
- Supply examining bed and other required supplies to Paro Airport medical room. It can be supplied by Paro hospital if they have it or else DVED can supply since they have it in stock. Mr. Kaka will follow up on this
- Additional surgical mask and bleaching powder/alcohol base hand wash will be procured

#### Hotline operation

- Identify an appropriate place to set up hotline
- Standard information to be used, it can be used from the IEC materials developed by ICB
- Identify at-least two relevant persons for the hotline operation

#### IEC Materials

- IEC materials to be approved and printed out and distributed to the immigration entry points/airport and hospitals

#### Surveillance

- JDWNRH and PHL will sort out the mechanism on the smooth functioning of ILI surveillance in JDWNRH
- Finalize the treatment guideline, infection guideline and PPE guideline and distribute to all hospitals

#### Fund mobilization

- CPO and IHR program will work on the fund mobilization either from WHO or World Bank project for the response activities to Inf A(H1N1)
